



Scholarship Program

The AAPCCA Board of Directors sponsors a scholarship fund with the intent of assisting AAPC's membership in times of financial hardship.

Requests for assistance with payment of goods and/or services include but are not limited to the following possibilities:

- National membership dues

- Required CEUs
- Registration for national or regional conferences
- Exam registration
- Exam prep tools, such as study guides or practice exams
- Other special requests (within reason, on a case-by-case basis)

Who can apply?
